Popular wisdom says that “beauty is in the eye of the beholder.” So is temptation. What is tempting to one person, may not be tempting to another. What are the temptations and/or tempters in your life? Is it hunger for things that you can’t have? Is it the safety of not growing beyond where you are today? Is it the power that you have over others? Take time this week and during the Season of Lent, to be aware of the things that take you away from God’s love and mercy. What are your temptations?

Every Friday during Lent there will be the praying of the Stations of the Cross. In accordance with the United States Conference of Bishops Committee on Divine Worship, we will not be having benediction with the stations. “Eucharistic exposition and benediction are no longer considered devotions, but rather are a part of the Church’s official liturgy. Whereas in the past benediction was frequently added on to the end of another service or devotion, this is no longer permitted. Eucharistic exposition and benediction is a complete liturgical service in its own right and is to be celebrated as such.” (www.usccb.org/liturgy/q&a/devotions/stats.shtml)

Every Monday afternoon we have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament beginning at 2:00. In the future we will be scheduling benediction with adoration on some of those afternoons.

Each week there will also be a fish bake at Our Lady of Mount Carmel sponsored by the Knights of Columbus. It’s a wonderful time to share a meal with others in the parish. It’s a great meal and a good deal too. I hope you will find time in your busy schedule to join us for prayer and fellowship on the Fridays of Lent.
